FUSE Program with Accreditation Exam: Anyone may take the exam, including allied health care professionals, medical students, non-medical professionals, and others with less than 1-year of clinical experience in the operating room; however, the exam is recommended for licensed physicians (including MD, DO, & MBBS), surgical technicians, and nurses, who have at least 1-year of OR experience. Reviewing the FUSE on-line didactic material and completing the Accreditation Exam provides up to 12 CME credits/ Continuing Nursing Education Contact Hours.
